	Expenditure £98.1kSurplus £10.9k

	received and increase in fees.								
	 Expenditure down by £6.4k due to staff absence and 								
	closure of Family Support.								
	- Result is we've gone from deficit of £12.2k to a surplus

	Income mostly day services income. Expenditure mostly								
	day services – staff, rent, activities etc.								
	 Looking ahead to 2024 – 2025
